

Lined Bib Apron

Fabric requirements:

- 1 yard of main fabric
- 1 yard of lining
- fat quarter for pockets optional

Cut from main fabric only:

- (2) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 27" for waist ties
- (2) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 20" for neck ties
- (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" for pockets (this can be cut from optional fat quarter)

Cut rectangle $28\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " from main fabric and lining. Fold lining in half. Mark $4\frac{1}{4}$ " from fold on top of short side. Mark $11\frac{1}{2}$ " down from top on open or non-folded side. Draw curved line between points to mark cutting line for bib. Cut along curved line. Lay other rectangle on top of first and mark cutting line for bib on second piece. Cut out bib on second piece.

Fold ties in half lengthwise and press. Open out ties and fold both long ends in towards the crease and press. Also fold one short end in on all 4 of the ties a $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Topstitch around open sides of all 4 ties.

Fold both short sides and one long side of pocket to inside about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and press. Fold remaining long edge in $\frac{1}{4}$ " and again $\frac{1}{4}$ " and topstitch top edge only. Center pocket on apron front. topstitch around both sides and bottom. Backtack on top edge. Stitch down center of pocket to divide in half or into thirds.

To put together, lay main piece right side up. Put ties on with raw edges just inside seam allowance of top of bib and on side at bottom of bib. The ties should be placed with the sewn ends to the inside of the apron. Put lining piece on top. Stitch all around the outside edge leaving an opening on bottom to turn inside out. Press and topstitch all around the outside edge.
