Flowers In The Cabin

To Create The Log Cabin Blocks:

Pick multiple fabrics in 4 dark color ranges and multiple fabrics in a light neutral range.
Cut all fabrics into 1 1/2" strips.

Cut 1 - 1 1/2" square from a light strip and 1 - 1 1/2" square from a dark strip

Piece these squares together

Cut 1 - 2 1/2" rectangle from a light strip and 1 - 2 1/2" rectangle from a dark strip

Turn the pieced squares so that the light square is on top.

Add the light 2 1/2" rectangle to the right side.

Add the dark 2 1/2" rectangle to the bottom side.

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" rectangle from a light strip and 1 - 3 1/2" rectangle from a dark strip

Add the dark 3 1/2" rectangle to the left side.

Add the light 3 1/2" rectangle to the right side.

Cut 1 - 4 1/2" rectangle from a light strip and 1 - 4 1/2" rectangle from a dark strip.

Add the light 4 1/2" rectangle to the right side.

Add the dark 4 1/2" rectangle to the bottom side.

Cut 1 - 5 1/2" rectangle from a light strip and 1 - 5 1/2" rectangle from a dark strip.

Add the dark 5 1/2" rectangle to the left side

Add the light 5 1/2" rectangle to the top side

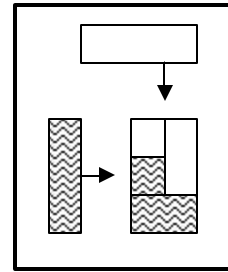
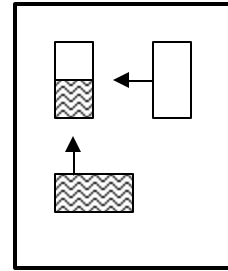
Cut 1 - 6 1/2" rectangle from a light strip and 1 - 6 1/2" rectangle from a dark strip

Add the light 6 1/2" rectangle to the right side

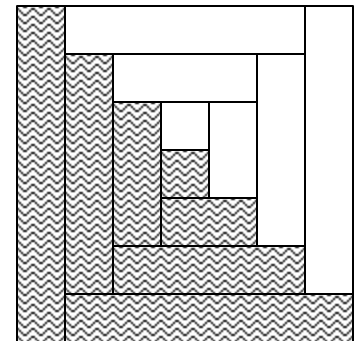
Add the dark 6 1/2" rectangle to the bottom side

Cut 1 - 7 1/2" rectangle from a dark strip

Add the dark 7 1/2" rectangle to the left side.



Finished Block



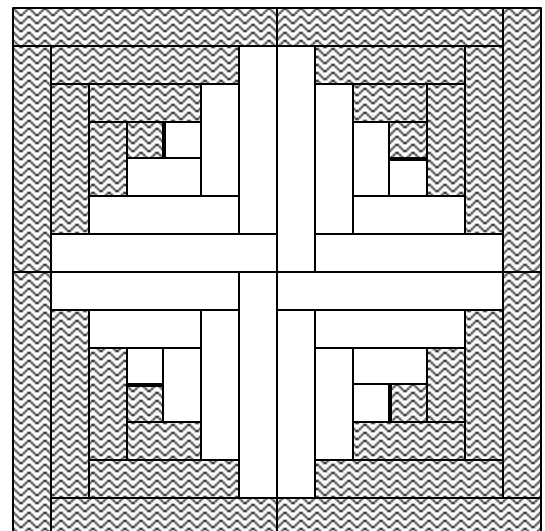
? Make 4 blocks with the same light/dark color combination.

? Make 4 sets with same light fabric and different dark fabric.

Attach the 4 blocks from same color range so that light colors create a diamond in the middle of the blocks.

Attach the 4 large blocks that you just created to make a large square.

Attach the 4 finished squares together to finish the body of the quilt.



To Create The Border:

Use the same 1 1/2" strips that were cut for the body of the quilt.

From each of the dark ranges, cut 2 – 14 1/2" rectangles and 2 – 15 1/2" rectangles

Pair same color range and measurements together and sew along the long edge.

Attach each set to the outside of the log cabin blocks to create a frame around the outside edge. Use complimentary colors rather than matching ranges with the blocks.

From the light strips, cut 8 – 5 1/2" rectangles, 32 – 4 1/2" rectangles, 32 – 3 1/2" rectangles, 32 – 2 1/2" rectangles, and 16 – 1 1/2" squares.

From each color range of the dark strips, cut 2 – 1 1/2" squares, 8 – 2 1/2" rectangles, 8 – 3 1/2" rectangles, 8 – 4 1/2" rectangles, and 4 – 5 1/2" rectangles.

Piece the rectangles and squares as follows:

5 1/2" dark & 1 1/2" light

4 1/2" dark & 2 1/2" light

3 1/2" dark & 3 1/2" light

2 1/2" dark & 4 1/2" light

1 1/2" dark & 5 1/2" light

You will need to make 8 additional pieces:

From light fabrics, cut 8 pieces measuring 1" x 5 1/2"

From the dark fabrics used for the 1 1/2" squares, also cut another piece measuring 1" x 1 1/2"

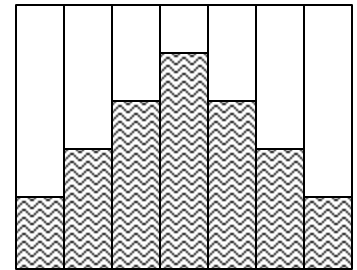
Connect these lights and darks to create 8 pieces measuring 1" x 6 1/2" each.

Keeping color ranges together, connect the pieced strips in the following order:

2 1/2" dark/4 1/2" light – 3 1/2" dark/3 1/2" light – 4 1/2" dark/2 1/2" light – 5 1/2" dark/1 1/2" light – 4 1/2" dark/2 1/2" light – 3 1/2" dark/3 1/2" light – 2 1/2" dark/4 1/2" light.

On ONE set of each color, add a 1 1/2" dark/5 1/2" light strip and the matching 1"x6 1/2" piece to the left side.

On A DIFFERENT set of each color, add a 1 1/2" dark/5 1/2" light strip and the Matching 1"x6 1/2" piece to the right side.

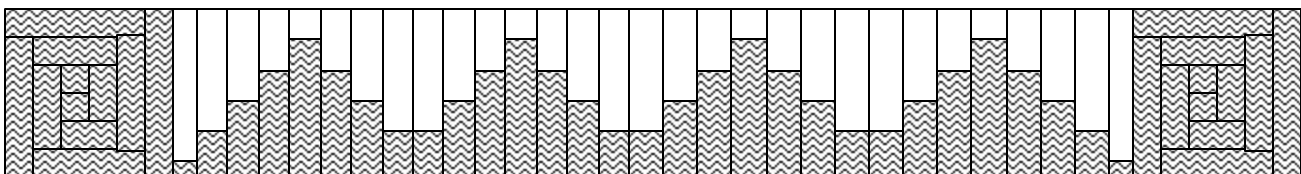


Now make ONE log cabin block from each color range using the assembly instructions from the quilt body with the exception of the final 2 pieces.

These will be the corner blocks and should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Create 4 border pieces by attaching the stripped color ranges together so that you use each color one time per piece, and each piece ends with the 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" additions.

Attach matching color ends to corner blocks, and attach final pieces to quilt.
